Outcomes by Intellectual Disability June 2022 Disability Employment Services (DES) – Employment Support Services (ESS) Sydney

The Commonwealth publishes outcomes by disability type for providers of Disability Employment Services (DES).

The Employment Support Service (ESS) program helps job seekers with disability get a job and provides ongoing support to keep a job.

Making an informed choice of provider makes a big difference in getting and keeping a job. People with disability and their families can:

- Choose a provider
- Move to a different provider if they are not happy
- Look at past provider outcomes to make an informed choice.

A 52-week outcome (from July 2018) is the proportion of jobseekers that started with a provider and got a job for at least 52 weeks.

Example 52-week outcome rate

10 people went to the provider



A 20% outcome rate means that 2 people got a job that lasted for at least 52 weeks.



An 80% outcome means that 8 people got a job that lasted for at least 52 weeks.



The national average 52-week outcome rate (proportion of people who got a job that lasted 52 weeks) was 24.1%.

The table below shows the 52-week outcome rates of the DES-ESS providers in the Sydney Labour Market Region (LMR) for jobseekers with intellectual disability as at 30 June 2022.
